Biography

Scott Richardson is the K-12 Program Coordinator for Learn and Serve America at the Corporation for National and Community Service. He has lead responsibility for all of Learn and Serve's programmatic and grantmaking activities in school-based service-learning. Scott is the former Director of Research and Design at Earth Force, a national nonprofit organization that prompts young people to take civic action to address the environmental problems they find in their communities. He wrote curriculum materials, directed teacher training, and oversaw evaluation for Earth Force. Before going to Earth Force, Mr. Richardson developed curriculum and trained teachers for the Close Up Foundation. He was Close Up's lead trainer for the Active Citizenship Today service-learning program, and he conducted Close Up trainings and programs in Russia, Palau, Micronesia, and the Marshall Islands. He chaired the curriculum committee of the National Council for the Social Studies in 2002 and was a Regional Trainer for the National Service-Learning Exchange.

Scott received a Master of Education degree from the University of Virginia in 1992 and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from Virginia Tech in 1985.
